Across England alone last year, there were nearly 500,000 incidents attended by fire and rescue services; nearly a third of them were fire incidents. For every million people in England there were 4.8 fire-related fatalities.

Household cooking appliances such as microwaves, toasters and kettles, which are also often used in offices, were the biggest cause of fires.

The impact of a fire-related incident can be enormous, both emotionally and financially, including medical, building repair and insurance costs, with potential fines for the individuals or businesses involved in the management of the property.

Understanding and identifying potential fire-related risks should be a high priority within your risk assurance policies and procedures. This training day will raise your understanding of the management and operational processes to enable effective prevention of fire-related incidents and ensure the safety and wellbeing of your workforce, tenants, customers and service providers.
