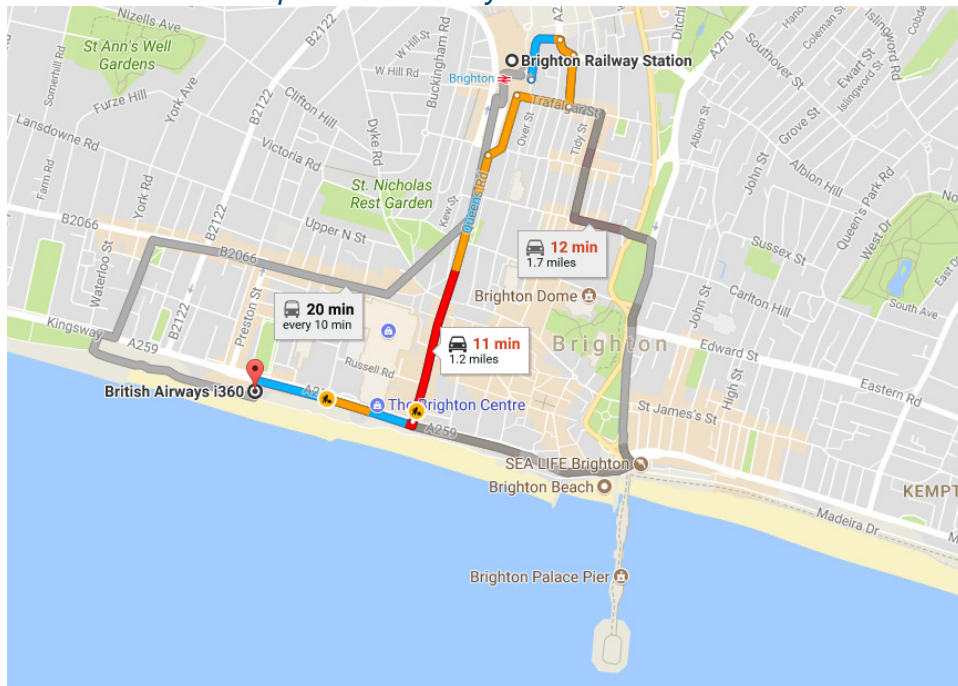


# British Airways i360

## Travel information

### By rail

- 15 minute walk from Brighton Station (BN1 3XP) or there is a taxi rank at the station.
- Brighton is under an hour from London with fast services from Victoria, St Pancras International, London Bridge and Clapham Junction. Brighton is half an hour from Gatwick Airport.
- There are also direct trains along the South Coast from many places including Portsmouth, Southampton, Eastbourne, and from Bristol.

### By car

- For a stress-free journey avoiding traffic hot spots, you are advised to approach British Airways i360 from the west. Please note that there are road works taking place at the junction of West Street (A2010) and Kings Road (A293) during 2016 to 2018, and therefore, drivers are advised to avoid this junction and to avoid approaching the attraction from the east.
- British Airways i360 is located directly opposite the Regency Square car park which has 507 spaces.

### ***By Bicycle***

- The National Cycle Network Route 2 runs alongside the A259 (Kings Road) on the promenade, right in front of British Airways i360.

### ***By bus***

- The closest bus stop to British Airways i360 is on Western Road (Waitrose), which is served by more fifteen local bus routes. These bus stops have accessible kerbs. It is a gentle five minute walk downhill to the seafront along Preston Street.
